1. **The following definitions apply in these Travel Award Program:**

“**bit.bio or we or us**” means Bit Bio Limited registered in England and Wales with company number 10466798.

“**you**” or “**your**” means the person or firm who applies to participate in this program.

2. **Terms and conditions**

2.1 **Eligibility and application**

(a) You must meet all the following criteria:

- must be an early career researcher (student or within 5 years post-degree);
- must provide us with a copy of your submitted abstract for the conference and it must include data collected using bit.bio ioCells;
- have not received the award in the last 12 months;
- have not received any other academic award from bit.bio;
- limited to receive one award for each conference;
- the conference must be in 2025 or 2026;
- you agree to provide relevant documentation to confirm your eligibility as listed above, which must include at least the following, details of your affiliation with the academic institution or your employer, confirmation of your attendance at the conference.
- bit.bio reserves the right to request additional information as needed to verify your eligibility.
- bit.bio reserves the right to approve or decline your application for this program at its sole discretion.
- bit.bio may cancel this program at any time without prior notice. If bit.bio cancels the program after you have submitted your application, unless bit.bio contacts you to inform that you have been successfully selected, your application will not proceed.

2.2 **Requirements**

(a) You must declare any conflicts of interest in your application;
